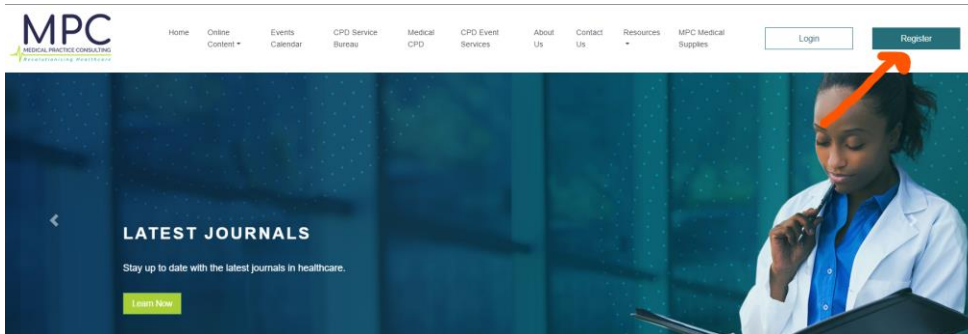


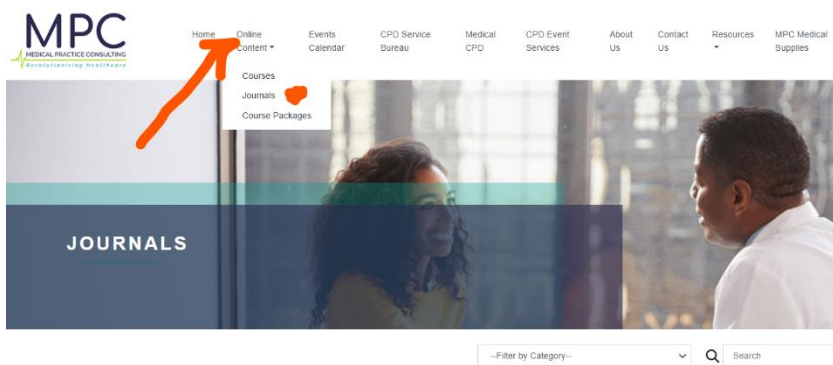
How to access SAJAA on MPC website:

Step 1: Go to www.mpconsulting.co.za

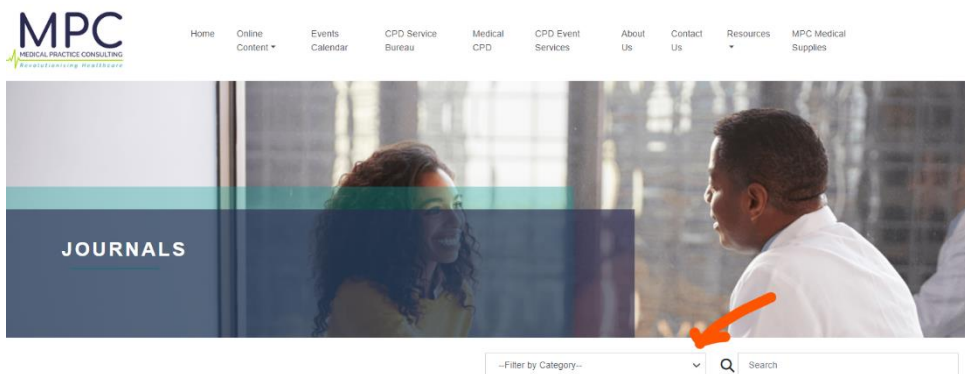
Step 2: Click on the register button in the top right corner of the page.
